Vision Statement

We will provide our students with the knowledge, skills and experiences they need to be able to make informed choices about their future career pathways. Students are given opportunities throughout the curriculum to make links to careers and develop lasting employability skills, preparing them for life after Elements Academy.

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Curriculum Overview –Zone B & Zone C

Term 1a

Learners to identify their passions, interests and skills, making connections between these and potential job roles.

Term 1b

Learners to identify their work style and be able to identify places of work that would and wouldn't suit their style.

Term 2a

Learners to explore different types of workplaces, such as offices, warehouses, home-working.

Term 2b

Learners to explore different types of employment, such as self-employment, freelancing, full-time employment.

Term 3a

Learners to explore what skills are needed in the workplace. These can be transferable or specific to the role.

Term 3b

Learners to look at the use of uniforms as well as Health and Safety legislation to ensure safety in the workplace.

Y2 – Term 1a

Learners to look at employment role models. Questioning who these people are and why they are inspirational.

Y2- Term 1b

Learners to identify and question stereotypes in careers. Challenging assumptions about career pathways.

Y2 – Term 2a

Students to meet with and discuss employers and discuss their roots, investigating various ways into employment.

Y2 – Term 2b

What are work environments and how do they differ? Students to research changes over time and how industry has progressed.

Y2 - Term 3a

Students to connect with their local community and see what opportunities and careers are local.

Y2 - Term 3b

Students to understand the routes into employment and the opportunities that are available to them.
